The National Ocean Accountability Levy

The ROO Act establishes a **90% Resource Reinvestment Contribution** from the industry’s highest-grossing violators to fund a permanent, self-sustaining **Ocean Repair Bucket**.

The “Blue Growth” Investment Plan
