

The Faith and Governmental Barricade (FGB) Act

A Legislative Framework for Targeted Revenue Realignment and Social Welfare

Section 1: The Revenue Mandate (The “Barricade” Levy)

To ensure that massive for-profit entities operating under religious guidance contribute to the secular infrastructure of the United States, this Act establishes a mandatory **90% Annual Profit Assessment** on identified organizations.

- **Total Estimated Annual Levy:\$3.32 Billion** (Based on 2025/2026 fiscal projections of the listed entities).

Section 2: The Maternal Security Allocation (60% of Funds)

The majority of the seized revenue shall be placed into a protected trust to fund the **Universal Single Motherhood Support Program**.

- **Annual Funding:\$1.99 Billion**
- **The “Care Package” Delivery:**
 - **Medical Solvency:** Direct payment of all out-of-pocket pregnancy and delivery costs for eligible single mothers.
 - **Postpartum Stipend:** A recurring monthly allowance of **\$1,000** for the first 12 months to cover diapers, formula, and infant necessities.
 - **Infrastructure Grant:** A one-time delivery of essential nursery hardware (safety-rated car seats, cribs, and high-efficiency strollers).
- **Capacity:** This fund is engineered to provide full support to **100,000 mothers** annually, targeting regions with the highest poverty-to-birth ratios.

Section 3: The Constitutional Separation Committee (40% of Funds)

The remaining revenue shall be directed to the **Legal Committee for Secular Governance (LCSG)**, a non-governmental legal action body.

- **Annual Funding:\$1.33 Billion**
- **Strategic Objectives:**
 - **Litigation Powerhouse:** Funding a permanent nationwide network of constitutional attorneys to challenge the integration of religious doctrine in public schools and legislative bodies.
 - **Tax Code Neutrality:** Actively lobbying for the repeal of the “Parsonage Allowance” and the removal of tax exemptions for for-profit businesses claiming religious status.
 - **Judicial Advocacy:** Providing expert witness testimony and amicus briefs for cases involving the Establishment Clause of the First Amendment.

Section 4: Enforcement and Transparency

- **The Transparency Audit:** Participating companies must submit quarterly verified profit statements to the Treasury to ensure the 90% levy is calculated accurately.
- **The Firewall Provision:** Funds in the “Barricade” bucket are strictly prohibited from being diverted to general government spending or military defense, ensuring the religious-to-secular transfer is direct and measurable.
